GENESIS

Juba Jyoti Jubak Sangha (JJJS) has its origin way back in 1974 when a raw motivation of doing something for the society led a group of young men to come together and formalise their association in a small village in Puri District of Odisha. Humble beginning as it had, it was engaged in making the people around more empowered by creating awareness on issues pertaining to their livelihood, health and social rights during its nascent days. Initially, these activities were carried out with the funds generated through informal donation. Later on, the organization started receiving grants-in-aid from government to intensify the programmes. As it grew up with its experience and acquired knowledge, the outfit gradually expanded in terms of activity as well as locale.

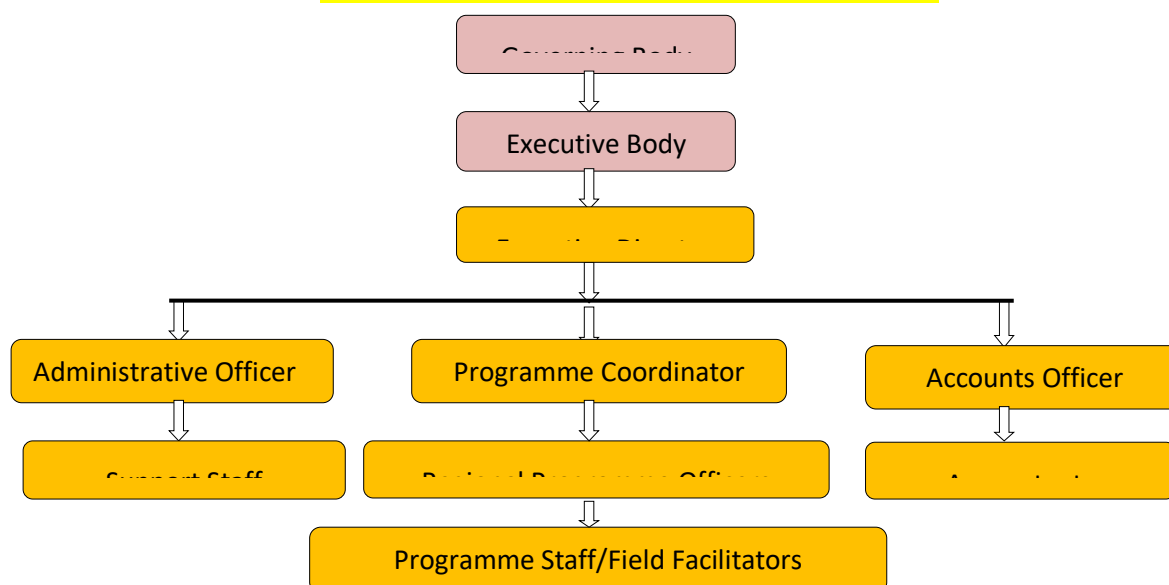

ACTIVITIES

Promoting Economic self reliance among the under privileged

1. Jan Shikshan Sansthan

Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) is an innovative Scheme of Ministry of HRD, Government of India in the field of non-formal and continuing education. Juba Jyoti Jubak Sangha is managing the Jana Shikshan Sansthan(JSS) in Subarnapur district since 2008-09 and till date around 20000 youths have been trained thus enhancing their employability.

- With our effort nearly 14321 nos. of trained beneficiaries have either been self employed or provided wage employment.



2. SHG & MED

- 300 nos. Of women SHGs formed under NABARD sponsored SHPI Programme in Puri district. Out of total 3620 members , 1854 members have been assisted in starting their MED.
- 130 nos. Of SHGs have been formed under NABARD sponsored SHPI Programme in Puri district. Out of total 1531 members , 865 members have been assisted in starting their MED.



3. SKILL TRAINING

- JJJS has been promoting employment linked skill training programmes in Tailoring, Rexin Bag making, Food Processing, Mobile Repairing, Agarbati making etc. in Subarnapur district of Odisha.
- Through these activities the unemployed youths from backward communities including some of PTGs are being provided skill training and back up assistance for their gainful employment. 3330 nos. of unemployed youths especially ladies have been trained in various trades as above and then engaged in the production centre managed by the organization to gain such practical knowledge and some seed money for starting their own production units.
- With support from the Development Commissioner, Handicrafts, Ministry of Textiles, GoI, the organization has conducted two training programmes on **Bamboo Craft** and **Jute Craft** for artisan groups as well as interested groups during 2012-13 in Sonapur. Also, an exhibition has been arranged for display and sale of a variety of handicraft products.



Promoting efforts for Reducing Drug Abuse

- JJJS has been promoting drug abuse prevention programme in order to reduce drug abuse and drug demand at Paralekhemundi under Gajapati district since last 7 years with our own resources



- A 10 bedded Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for addicts is under operation in which alcoholic as well as substance drug addicts are being provided drug de-addiction and rehabilitation services on residential basis.
- Till date 3246 nos. Of addicts have been benefited under the project

Assisting Disadvantaged Sections of the Society

1. Home for Senior citizens for women

- A senior Citizen Home for indigent older persons is being run at Sonepur under Subarnapur district.
- 50 nos. Of distressed senior citizens are being benefited which is being managed by organization from its own resources.



2. Welfare of Transgender Persons

A home for transgender persons in need is being managed by our organization at Bhubaneswar in which 15 nos. of TGs are being provided residential rehabilitation along with means for their long term rehabilitation.

3. Swadhar Greh

The home for women in difficult circumstances named as Swadhar Greh is being Managed by JJJS in Subarnapur district of Odisha since 2007 proving residential rehabilitation to women of 18 to 60 years age group. The project is sponsored by the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. Of India



- Till the end of the year 2021-22 the said project has provided service to 323 nos. Of women out of which 288 nos. of women have been rehabilitated.
- The project provides integrated care & support that includes lodging, boarding, healthcare, clothing, vocational training, legal assistance and rehabilitation assistance to enable them to live independently. The dependent children of the women also got assistance.

4. UJJAWALA

JJJS managed the Ujjawala Programme in Subarnapur district of Odisha with assistance from W & CD Ministry during the period from 2011-12 to 2017-18 in which programmes were organized to create awareness against Trafficking of girls. Also efforts were made for rescue of the victims of trafficking.

5. One Stop Centre (SAKHI)

JJJS has been running “One Stop Centres (OSCs)” with assistance from Govt. of India, Ministry of Women & Child Development which objects to support women affected by violence, in private and public spaces, within the family, community and at the workplace. Women facing physical, sexual, emotional, psychological and economic abuse, irrespective of age, class, caste, education status, marital status, race and culture will be facilitated with support and redressal. Aggrieved women facing any kind of violence due to attempted sexual harassment, sexual assault, domestic violence, trafficking, honour related crimes, acid attacks or witch-hunting who have reached out or been referred to the OSC will be provided with specialized services



- In the One Stop Centres run by JJJS in Rayagada district since September'2019, 346 no. of cases have been registered and provided service till March'2022.
- The One Stop Centres run by JJJS in Subarnapur district Started in August'2019 and closed in July'21, 123 no. of cases have been registered and provided service till July'2022.

6. Children's Home

JJJS is managing a Children's Home at Sonepur with assistance from Women & Child Development Deptt., Govt. of Odisha. Under ICPS Scheme of Ministry of Women Child Development, Govt. of India since 2011-12. At present the strength of children 50. These children are in need of care and protection and through the Children's Home being provided with institutional services for their rehabilitation. The services being provided to them include shelter, nutritious food as per the prescribed menu, healthcare, education, recreational and vocational training for their all-round capacity building.



- 160 nos. of children in need of care of protection have been admitted in Children's Home located at Sonepur, Dist-Subarnapur and 118 nos. of children have been deinstitutionalised till the end of financial year 2021-22.



7. Specialized Adoption Agency (SAA)

Juba Jyoti Jubak Sangha has been recognized by Govt. Of Odisha, Women & Child Development Deptt. as SAA for Subarnapur district with effect from 09.02.2017. SAA facilitates the placement of orphaned, abandoned or surrendered children for adoption in accordance with the provisions of various guidelines for adoption issued from time to time, by the State Government, or the Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) and notified by the Central Government.



The SAA located at Sonepur of Subarnapur district has been instrumental in promoting adoption of 12 nos. of children. At present two children are staying and the process is on for their adoption.

8. Outsourcing of Designated Functions of SSEPD Deptt.

Our organization was approved by Govt. of Odisha, SSEPD Deptt. as one of the Service Providers for implementation of above work in four districts like Boudh, Subarnapur, Jharsuguda & Deogarh on outsourcing basis.

- Our organization engaged personnel at G.P. level in all the above 4 districts of Odisha starting from December'2017 to carry out all the activities of SSEPD Deptt. on outsourcing basis like survey, identification of PwDs and certification, need assessment, rehabilitation of PwDs, drug addicts, beggars, transgender, senior citizens and take steps for streamlining the distribution of



pensions through Aadhar Seeding, deletion of dead and ineligible beneficiaries and updating of pensioners data base on the online portal.

- Thousands of PwDs including MD, MR, CP, Autism were identified, screened, empanelled for IGNDP, UDID, Scholarships for themselves and their children pursuing education, involved in PwD SHG formation, provided Aids & Appliances, Vocational Training and Self Employment Kit, Involvement in NREGA Programme for livelihood etc.

Ensuring Minimum Health & Hygiene for the Rural Mass

In order to improve the health status among the households in the areas the organization working in, it has executing many projects pertaining to Primary healthcare, Health awareness and Community health.



MANAGEMENT OF PHC (NEW)

- JJJS successfully managed four such PHC (N)s in the state. Each health centre was managed by a team consisting of a MBBS doctor, an AYUSH doctor, a Pharmacist, a Laboratory Technician, an ANM, a Staff Nurse, an attendant and a Project Coordinator.

TARGETED INTERVENTION FOR PREVENTION OF HIV/AIDS

- JJJS has executed the project with support from Odisha State AIDS Control Society (OSACS) during 2010-11. It has provided orientation to 200 FSWs and 100 MSMs.

Activities conducted for Core HRG TIs:

- District level mapping of HRGs and planning
- Focus on coverage of clients of sex workers
- and partners of MSM as well as IDUs
- Linkages between TI and continuum of care
- Focus on enabling environment (including equitable access to services)
- Forming CBOs to represent the community
- Setting up Technical Support Units at the state level to enhance the capacity of partners and quality of interventions

HEALTH SCHEME FOR V4 SUB CENTRE

JJJS were engaged as a Field NGO (FNGO) by National Health Mission (NHM), Odisha to implement the NGO Scheme for V4 Sub Centres in Sonepur district with the following objectives.

- To complement and supplement the role of the government in quality health care delivery system.
- To address the unmet health needs in un-served and underserved areas.
- To build strong institutional capacity at the District & Block level.
- To address the gaps in information on health services in the project area.
- To advocate for the community to get health entitlements.

Under this initiative outreach and support services are being provided in 7 Sub Centres of Ullunda Block of Subarnapur district of Odisha.

TRAINING TO COMMUNITY LEVEL HEALTH WORKERS- ASHA/AWW

In its effort to see vibrant community level health workers, JJJS with support from National Health Mission (NHM), Odisha is organizing training programmes for ASHAs and Anganwadi workers in Sonepur district since 2012-13.

- In ASHA training, 5-days programmes on various modules have been completed for 30 batches consisting of 900 trainees.
- In training for Anganwadi workers, 12 batches of 8-days programme on Integrated Management of Neonatal & Childhood Illness (IMNCI) have been completed so far.



SANITATION

JJJS was involved in construction of IHHL in Subarnapur, Boudh, districts of Odisha with assistance from RWS & S. Till the end of the year 320 nos. of IHHL has been constructed for the beneficiaries.

OUTSOURCING AGENCY IN RSBY

The organization was appointed as the outsourcing agency for implementation of Rastriya Swasthya Bima Yojana (RSBY), the health insurance scheme for BPL families, for the year 2011-12 and 2012-13 by the CDMO, Sonepur.

CALL CENTRE FOR PREGNANT MOTHERS

JJJS in partnership with the District Health Administration, a Call Centre was established during 2012-13 at Sonepur to provide communication services to pregnant women by immediate arrangement of ambulance

EDUCATION

NON FORMAL EDUCATION

Under a project of the Ministry of HRD, GoI, Non-Formal Education has been promoted in Khalikote block of Ganjam district of the state. During the project, closed in 2001, 689 nos. of f out of school children of (6-14) years age group were provided elementary education through 25 centres spread in the rural and interior pockets of Khalikote block of the district

EDUCATIONAL COMPLEX FOR ST GIRLS

In the year 2012 Juba Jyoti Jubak Sangha established an Educational Complex at Kesinga, Kalahandi for girls of Scheduled Tribe community. This institution provides education based on school curriculum. In addition to this, the students are provided various vocational training to make them employment-ready.



SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE

- JJJS was associated with Agriculture Technology Management Agency (ATMA) established under National Agricultural Technology Project (NATP).
 - Popularization of Mustard cultivation under RKVY during Rabi 2011-12 in Sonepur.
 - Procurement and marketing of Water Melon in the state in 2012.



- Demonstration of Paddy in Birmaharajpur Block, Sonapur during 2012-13.
 - Cultivation of Hybrid Maize during Rabi 2012-13 in Sonapur.
 - Demonstration of A3P and intercropping during Kharif 2012-13 in Sonapur.
 - Organization of farmer's training programme under ISOPOM (Oilseeds) during 2012-13 in Birmaharajpur Block, Sonapur.

 - Introduction and Expansion of Improved Pigeon pea (Arhar) Production Technology in Rain fed Upland Ecosystems in Orissa, in partnership with ICRISAT in Kalahandi district during 2011-12.
 - Distribution of Groundnut Seeds for Seed Village Programme during 2012-13 under Office of the Deputy Director of Agriculture, Sonour.
 - Demonstration of Line Transplanting of Paddy in Sonapur under 2nd Green Revolution under RKVY Scheme during Kharif 2011-12.
 - Implementation of project on Green Gram Cultivation in Kalahandi district in PPP mode in partnership with IMAGE, Odisha during 2011-12.
 - Organising training programmes for farmers on agricultural issues in Kalahandi, Sonapur, Boudh and Gajapati districts from time to time by engaging agriculture experts.
 - Organising Farmers Meets regularly in Kalahandi, Sonapur, Boudh and Gajapati districts.

TRAINING TO PRIs

In a tripartite agreement with State Institute for Rural Development (SIRD), Odisha and District Rural Development Agency (DRDA), Sonapur, JJJS as the Collaborating Partner Organization (CPO) has implemented the training for elected Representatives of Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs) in Sonapur Block during 2012-13. JJJS has successfully discharged the responsibilities in the project.
